



**Alma de Cattleya 2016 Pinot Noir**

**92 points**

The 2016 Pinot Noir is a very pretty, supple wine with lovely purity in its fruit and aromatics. Sweet red berry, rose petal, mint and spice all flesh out in this mid-weight, refreshing Pinot from Bibiana González-Rave. Dried flowers and subtle earthy notes add nuance on the persistent finish.



**Alma de Cattleya 2016 Chardonnay**

**90 points**

The 2016 Chardonnay from Alma de Cattleya speaks in quite, hushed tones. Orchard fruit, dried flowers and chamomile give this understated Chardonnay lovely aromatic complexity. Drink it over the next few years.
